#### Angelica's PBIS Coaching Tips:

- **Involve** all stakeholders in the decision-making process; you will have a better chance of getting staff and student buy-in.
- **STUDENTS' VOICE** has helped Landmark evolve into a place where kids love to come and learn.
- **Provide** training to new students.
- **NETWORKING** with other schools and tuning in on **ZOOM** chats are beneficial, especially when you're looking for new ideas, incentives, events, etc.
- **Be consistent and persevere** because the result will be well worth it!!
