- Involve all stakeholders in the decisionmaking process; you will have a better chance of getting staff and student buy-in.

- Provide training to new students.
- NETWORKING with other schools and tuning in on ZOOM chats are beneficial, especially when you're looking for new ideas, incentives, events, etc.
- Be consistent and persevere because the result will be well worth it!!
