PBIS allows the flexibility to target students' needs and wants which ultimately leads to relationship building among student and teachers as well as among staff.

#### **Kimberly's PBIS Coaching Tips:**

- Use the Tiered Fidelity Inventory (TFI) to pinpoint areas in which to focus and build secure foundational systems.
- Also, focus on staff buy-in and systems to support fidelity of implementation; this will go a long way toward seeing improvement.
