Topic: Planning Effective Booster Trainings

Staff Booster Training

- Base boosters on survey or assessment data (e.g., Self-Assessment Survey).
- Keep it simple: stick to one topic at a time.
- Follow up to ensure understanding; provide additional support to those that need it.
- Consider convenient times and alternate formats.

Student Booster Training

- Base boosters on school-wide discipline data (e.g., high • rate of referrals from cafeteria during all lunch periods).
- Review expectations and acknowledgement system after • long breaks; follow up to ensure understanding.
- Plan ahead! Build boosters into the school calendar.

What about families and community?

- Keep the lines of communication open: consider providing newsletters & emails with reminders of the school-wide expectations and how students can be acknowledged for positive behavior; feature PBIS on your school website!
- Invite families and community to participate in PBIS activities, sporting events, fundraisers, etc. Invite local media, too!
