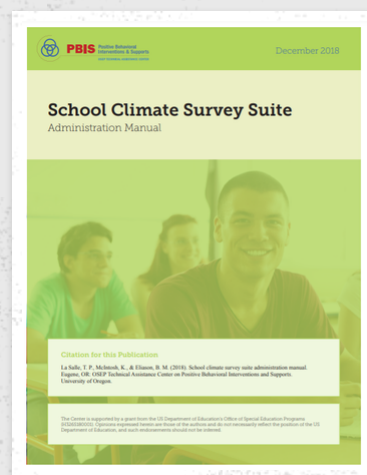
We want your input on summer training opportunities

We can help you get set up to use these **free surveys** with your school community! [The suite](#) includes separate surveys for elementary students, middle/high school students, school staff/personnel, and families. All surveys are available online, with links we can provide for you that will be available for a window of time. The surveys are also available as pencil and paper surveys, with data being entered manually.



PBIS Apps provides data reports (for free!) broken down by demographic groups, by sub-scales, and by items. This suite can help you understand how different groups within your community feel about the school climate, which will help you with specific action planning items.

Tier II Tidbit

What is Check-in, Check-out (CICO)?

[CICO](#) is a [Tier II intervention](#) for students with recurring minor behaviors (few major office referrals), who are seeking adult attention. Students are matched with a mentor who meets briefly with the student before and after school each day, giving them positive attention and encouragement to follow the expectations. Students also check in with teachers throughout the day to get positive and corrective feedback on following the expectations. The typical daily/weekly process looks like this:



Daily -

- student meets with mentor before school; student is given a data collection sheet
- student receives prompts and feedback from classroom teachers (using data sheet)
- student meets with mentor at end of day; data are recorded; report sent home to parents

Weekly -

- data are totaled and graphed
- data are used to make decisions on intervention
