Back to Basics: Is Your PBIS Tier I Foundation Solid? June 7, 2023 at A-State, 8:30 am - 3:30 pm

This training is intended for teams who would like a refresher on Tier I of PBIS and/or need to improve their current implementation efforts. Participants will learn... Burnout is like the canary in the coalmine... the response should focus on making the environment less toxic... not just trying to make the canary more resilient.

- How to implement the major components of PBIS Tier I with fidelity
- How to use data for continuous improvement


